THE Red Hill Special School has received a donation of specialised equipment for its students valued at more than \$34,000.

The Australian Medical Association (Queensland Branch) established a not-for-profit charity, the AMAQ Foundation, and through their fundraising efforts this year were able to donate the equipment to the school.

Red Hill Special School principal Pam Stack said the support of the AMAQ Foundation over the past two
